

Board Nominations

The Credit Union is accepting nominations for the Credit Union Board of Directors. A Nominating Committee, appointed by the Board Chairperson, will submit a slate of officers for election. Anyone, other than those submitted by the Nominating Committee, who wishes to run for office and have their name placed on the ballot must:

1. Submit a resume to the Nominating Committee stating their qualifications.
2. File a petition signed by at least 50 Credit Union members accompanied by a statement that he or she will fulfill the requirements and will serve if elected.

Any candidate seeking a position must also meet bylaw qualifications, including the following:

- a) Must be a member in good standing of the Credit Union.
- b) Unless in dispute, all financial obligations must be in a current status and must be making payments on financial obligations according to schedule.
- c) Must have no record of bankruptcy within the past six years.
- d) Must qualify for surety bonding at standard rates.

Petition and nominee statement forms are available at Credit Union offices. Only these forms may be used, and the candidates themselves must pick them up.

Only Credit Union members may sign the petition. A member may only sign once, and signatures must be in ink with names as they appear on the Credit Union account. Other requirements, deadlines, etc., will be explained on the petition itself. No further nominations will be taken after the deadline date of December 1st. Qualified nominees will be publicized in the Credit Union offices by January 1st.
